

CatWorldly cat gear measurement checklist
CatWorldly

- Measure the cat's length, height, weight and mobility before buying fixed-size gear.
- Carrier: cat should be able to stand, turn around and lie down; floor and latch must be secure.
- Litter box: longer than the cat from nose to tail base; entry should match age and mobility.
- Scratcher: tall or long enough for a full stretch; base should not wobble.
- Cat tree: platforms must match cat size and confidence; anchor tall structures when possible.
- Feeder or fountain: food and water-contact parts should be removable and easy to clean.
- Label the recommendation honestly: research-based comparison, editorial selection, hands-on tested or specification guide.
- Add affiliate disclosure near product links if affiliate links are used.
