

CatWorldly Gear Sizing Guide

CatWorldly

Carrier

- Cat should be able to stand, turn around and lie down.
- Floor should stay rigid under the cat's weight.
- Door and latches should close securely.

Litter box

- Box should be longer than the cat from nose to tail base when possible.
- Entry should match the cat's age, size and mobility.
- Placement matters as much as box style.

Scratcher

- Tall enough for a full stretch.
- Stable enough not to wobble.
- Texture should match what the cat already tries to scratch.

Cat tree or perch

- Base should be stable.
- Platforms should match cat size and confidence.
- Anchor tall pieces where appropriate.

Food and water gear

- Food-contact parts should be easy to remove and clean.
- Check pump, reservoir, corners and seals on fountains.
- Automated feeders still need daily inspection.

Label reminder

CatWorldly should label gear content as research-based comparison, editorial selection, hands-on tested or specification guide.
