

CatWorldly home safety and vet-call checklist
CatWorldly

- Call a veterinarian or emergency clinic now for breathing trouble, collapse, repeated vomiting, inability to urinate, seizures, suspected poisoning, severe pain, major injury or fast-changing symptoms.
- Keep toxin and medication labels available if poisoning is possible.
- Do not wait for a social-media answer during urgent symptoms.
- Record timing, appetite, water intake, litter-box changes and visible injuries.
- Keep the cat warm, quiet and contained while arranging professional help.
- Use local veterinary guidance for vaccine timing, parasite control and legal requirements.
